


A spooked turkey can run at speeds up to 20 miles per hour.




THANKSGIVING FUN FACT:

More than 40 million green bean casseroles are served on Thanksgiving.




THANKSGIVING FUN FACT:

Turkeys were the most plentiful meat available at the time of the first Thanksgiving, starting the tradition.




THANKSGIVING FUN FACT:
