the front \_\_\_\_\_.

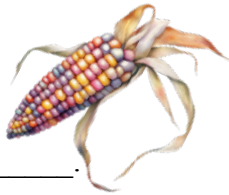


### THANKSGIVING FUN FACT:

where you keep your school \_\_\_\_\_.

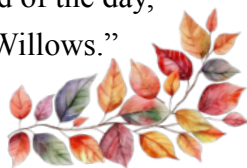


### THANKSGIVING FUN FACT:
